The options reported in this row were granted to the Reporting Person by the Issuer on September 30, 2025 and vest and become exercisable in 12 equal monthly installments over a vesting period that commenced on December 1, 2025 and will conclude on the one-year anniversary of the vesting commencement date (December 1, 2026), by which time all such options will be fully vested and exercisable.
